

LEGAL NOTICE

“MODIFICATION TO REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS”

The Youth Council of the Greater New Bedford Workforce Investment Board, Inc. (WIB) is issuing a **Modification**, dated Monday, April 26, to its **Framework Services** Request for Proposals from educational institutions, private businesses, labor organizations, trade and professional associations, and social service and community-based organizations. The Modification requires the inclusion of Follow-Up Services in Framework Services proposals. Failure to provide program and budget information on Follow-Up Services for all youth will render the applicant ineligible for funding.

Follow-up services are emphasized as one of the ten required youth program elements. All youth participants must receive some form of follow-up services for a minimum of 12 months after exit from one of the ten program elements. The types of follow-up services provided are determined based on the needs of each individual youth and may include, but are not limited to, regular contact with youth to track and document year-round activities, job shadowing, career exploration, telephone calls or mailings, adult mentoring, or tutoring.
